TODAY'S GOSPEL deals with a subject that concerns us all - forgiveness.

Jesus was a brilliant teacher. He used stories a lot because it was a simple way to get across His message. Peter asked Him a question. He asked: "How often should I forgive my brother". Peter went on to hazard a guess by suggesting seven times. In this he thought he was being generous and he probably expected to receive Jesus' approval but to his amazement, Jesus replied "not seven times but seventy seven-times." This was an expression among the Jews, meaning endless or indefinitely.

Forgiveness clears a path for God to forgive us. The only obstruction we can put in the way of God's forgiveness of our sins is our inability to forgive the sins of others. God will indeed "write off" our debt but there is a catch. If we want forgiveness for our sins from God, we must forgive those who offend us.

"All-powerful and merciful God, grant that we who always stand in need of Your forgiveness and love may be always ready to forgive and show mercy and compassion to others."
